Did you know?



We're moving to two rounds of application funding.

To better support our community partners and provide more flexibility, Community Bank - Parkdale will move to offering only **TWO rounds of sponsorship funding each year.**

This change means more opportunities to plan, apply for support, and bring your community projects to life when it suits you best.

What does this mean for my community group / club?

- Grant or sponsorship applications for 2025 are now CLOSED.
- The first round will open **1 February** and close on **28 February 2026.**
- The second round will open **1 September** and close on **30 September 2026.**
- You will no longer be able to apply for funding in between or outside of these rounds.
- You will be eligible to apply **ONCE** per year.
- You will need to choose either the February or September round based on your club / organisation / event needs.

- You must attach a reference from your school in the application (Principal / Teacher / Careers Counsellor)

As a successful recipient you agree to be involved in attending Community events, social media profiling and community newsletters

Applications are invited from eligible students who require assistance with Tertiary education costs in 2026. **Applications now open.**

SALT

Bendigo Banks contribute to \$500,000 funding to boost youth wellbeing

Community Bank Parkdale is one of seven Victorian Community Banks to partner with leading not-for-profit health education group Sport and Life Training (SALT), helping fund a \$500,000 commitment to enhance player wellbeing and resilience.

SALT works with junior and senior players - plus their coaches and managers - in local sporting clubs, running targeted sessions designed to foster a positive culture and also promote wellbeing within the broader community. The new funding, to be rolled out over five years, will allow the organisation to expand the number of sessions it runs and also enable the hiring of several key roles.

Founder of SALT, David Burt said the funding will help take SALT to the next level of impact. "We would not be here were it not for our partnership with Bendigo Bank's Community Banks," Mr Burt said. "The Community Banks don't just support us; they support hundreds of clubs to access our programs."

Bendigo Bank's Community Bank model ensures a portion of the profits from each Community Bank are returned to the community, delivering a record \$50.2 million of investment for community strengthening projects in the 2025 financial year.

More than \$416 million has been returned to communities via donations, grants, scholarships and sponsorships since the inception of the Community Bank model in 1998.
